Decorative head and tail pieces and initial captitals. Contents with some light marking. One plate looks to have been torn out, and there are some stubs which look to be the stubs of existing rather than absent plates. In the original publisher's brown morocco leather and buckram bindings, with marbled endpapers and all page edges marbled. Classed as fair because the bindings are in fair to poor condition. Vol I has loss from the top of the spine, some marking on the front board and splitting at the endpaper joint with the book block both front and rear - although the stitching is sound and the book is holding together quite tightly. Vol II is in better condition but with nibbling and fragmentation at the top and bottom of the spine. Internally they are generally free from foxing and the contents are in good to very good condition. Plate IX has some marking to the rear which partly shows through on the plate margin.
