Both volumes have 2 armorial bookplates at the front endpapers. The pastedown endpapers have the bookplate of Prince Augustus Frederick, Duke of Sussex (1773-1843) with the motto 'si deus pro nobis quis contra nos' (if God is for us, who can be against us?'. Volume I is internally complete and very clean. 415pp. Volume II which contains the Edda and additional notes, has some staining which starts at p 156. It is mostly at the bottom margin and bottom gutter to page 244. From p 247 the staining is further up the gutter, and towards the end the paper becomes quite fragile. There is a hole and general paper damage to the rear free endpaper but the text pages remain intact and readable. It is likely that the book became damp and affected by mould. 356 pp. Fair.
